Managing conflicts in natural resource management is emerging as one of the key capabilities required for sustainable development. There is a need for consensus building activities in order to improve the outcomes of the community based forest management efforts and reduce the negative impact of these efforts and provide disadvantaged communities with increased opportunities to use and manage natural resources.

The objective of the Project is to introduce innovative and effective collaborative management activities at the community level for more efficient use and sustainable management of natural resources for the rural poor. It will finance capacity building activities that support the implementation of the Andhra Pradesh Community Forest Management (P073094) Project and complement the Jharkhand Participatory Forest Management (P077192) Project currently under preparation, and also Capacity Building for Community Forest Management (TF053826) Project, Madhya Pradesh.
