The project developed methodologies and framework for Natural Resource Accounting of Forest and Land in the states of Himachal Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh (physical and monetary terms), keeping in view the SEEA Framework of United Nations. More specifically, the major output of the study comprised of generation of various resource accounting tables for land and forestry sector respectively using secondary and primary data. For the Land Sector, the output comprised of Land Resource Accounts (Core), Soil Resource Accounts (Link), and Land Use Accounts (Supplementary accounts). For the Forest Sector, it provides details in terms of Physical Asset accounts- Commercial working Physical Asset accounts- Volume and Area, Monetary Asset accounts- Volume and Area, Flow Accounts-Goods and Services, Degradation and Depletion Account- Physical and Monetary, Expenditure Statement for Forestry Management & Protection, Accounting matrix for Ecological Services/Amenities.
