

## **Strengthening capacity to integrate valuation into response policy for management of ecosystem services for poverty alleviation in South Asia**

The project is implemented through the Consortium of organisations comprising of SWIMMER, U.K. – the coordinating institution and University of Cambridge University of Oxford, UNEP’s Ecosystem Economics Research Unit in Nairobi, IIFM, Bhopal; ATREE, Bangalore; GIDR, Ahmedabad; NEHU, Shillong; CISED, Bangalore; WII, Gurgaon; CHIRAG and PSI, Dehradun as core partners. IIFM was assigned the task of producing a position paper in the form of Output-I of the project and a toolkit in the form of a Guidance manual for Valuation of Ecosystem Services in collaboration with UNEP and University of Liverpool, UK through consultation process, workshops and literature review. Two position papers have been published with joint authorship of the partner institutions, one each in Natural Environment Research Council and United Nations Environment Programme.
